Formally known as *Mommy & Me*, *Just You & Me* is a program for children who will be 16 months—3 years. Alongside a parent or other caregiver, children will have the opportunity to participate in an array of preschool experiences including center time, dramatic play, crafts, creative movement, and story time. It's a wonderful opportunity to share the fun and excitement of your child's first school experience.

Classes meet on Tuesday's from 9:45—11:00am. The program runs from September through May. The tuition for this class is \$50.00 per month and a one time activity fee of \$20.00. Due to the participatory nature of our program, please note that younger or older siblings are not permitted to attend. Children in this program do not have to be potty trained.
