



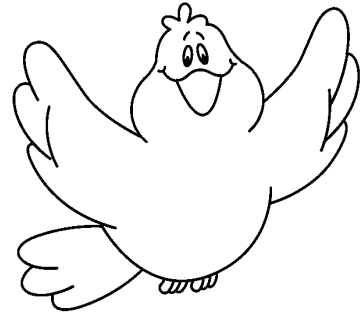
Bensalem Christian Day School

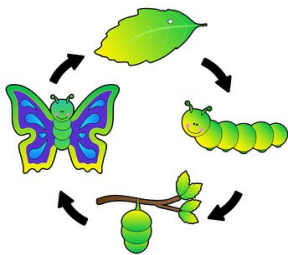

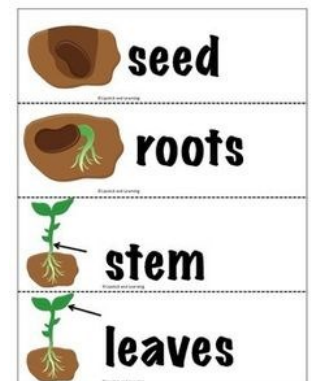
